Financial Aid in the Fall

As we enter the month of November, I would like to extend my heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to our high school team, who have supported our senior students during this busy college and financial aid application season. Students and families feel your genuine care, and you are helping make dreams come true by showing them that the sky is the limit when it comes to life after high school.

This month marks the deadline for submitting applications to the University of California and California State University for first-year freshmen. Although the application deadline for most UC and CSU campuses is December 1, 2025, students are encouraged to submit their applications before Thanksgiving Break to allow for adequate time for review by the Counseling Department.

They will also be launching their applications on the CaliforniaColleges.edu platform to streamline the application process.

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and California Dream Act Application (CADAA) are also available for students to apply, and each senior will need to complete a financial aid application in accordance with Education Code. Workshops and individual meetings will be provided throughout November in order to guide students and families in submitting these important applications.

- Talk about what you are thankful for using complete sentences to build vocabulary.
- Read together and ask questions about characters who show kindness to boost comprehension.
- Write short thank you notes or gratitude lists to support writing skills.
